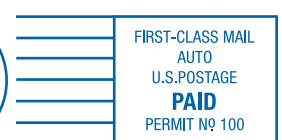

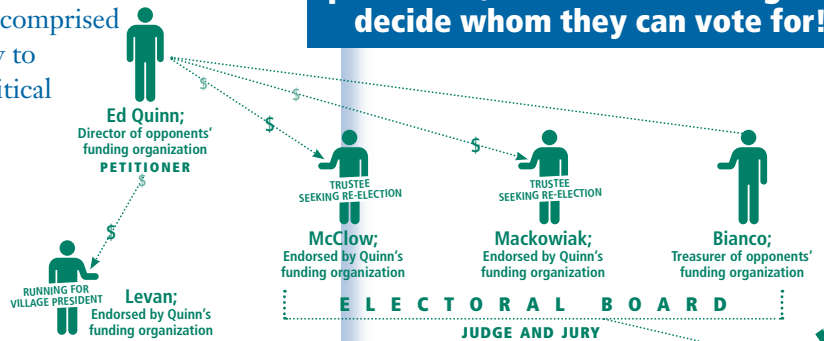
2 Do you want uncontrolled growth to swallow our community?

Why did the opponents vote in favor of five-story condo projects on land that was originally zoned for single-family housing without regard to the added population density, the added traffic, the added congestion, and the added burden on taxpayers. Or even take into consideration the current zoning in place for the parcel being developed? Because they support growth at any cost and can't be trusted to make decisions that benefit the people of Winfield. Tell the guys with the green signs NO!
